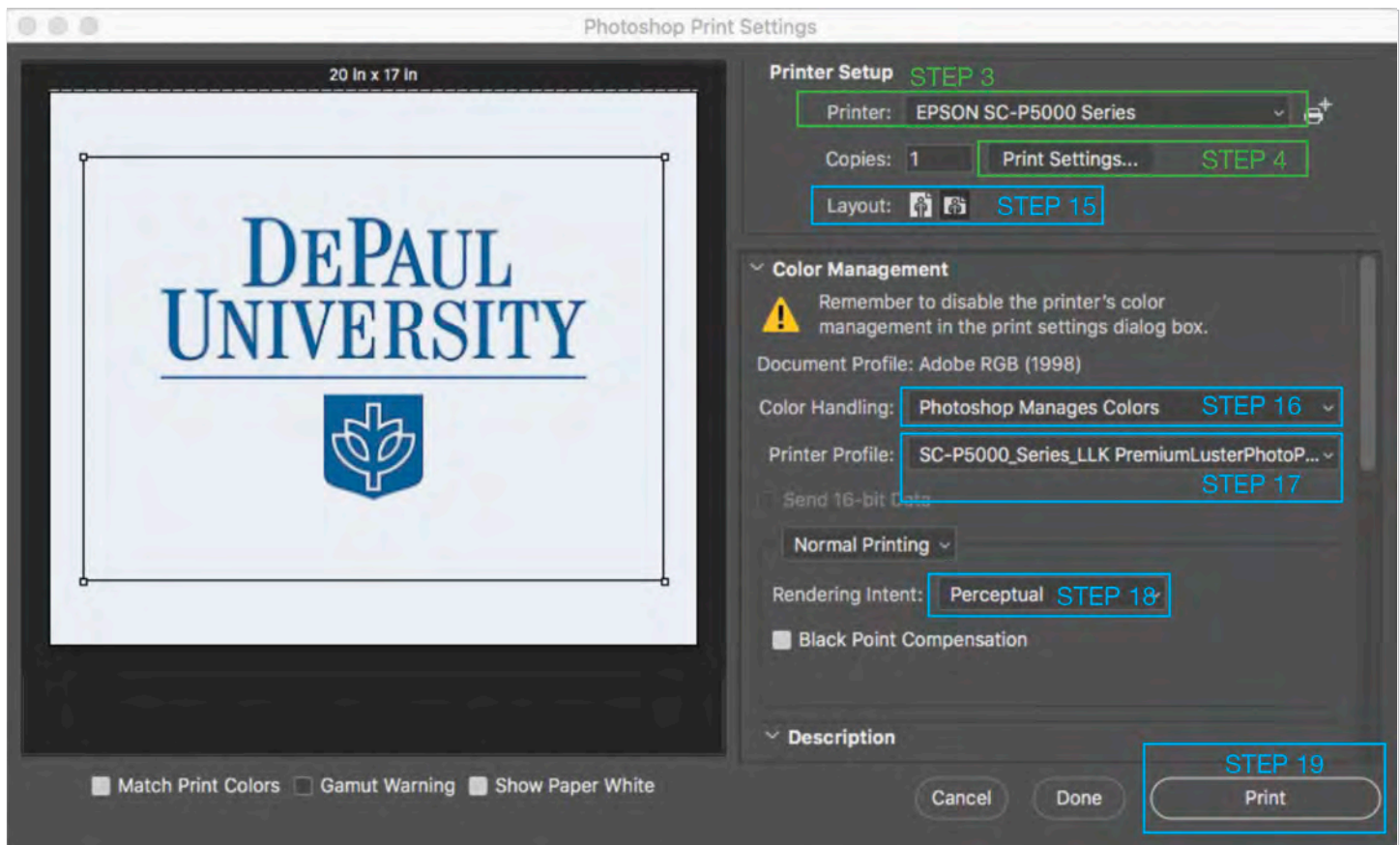




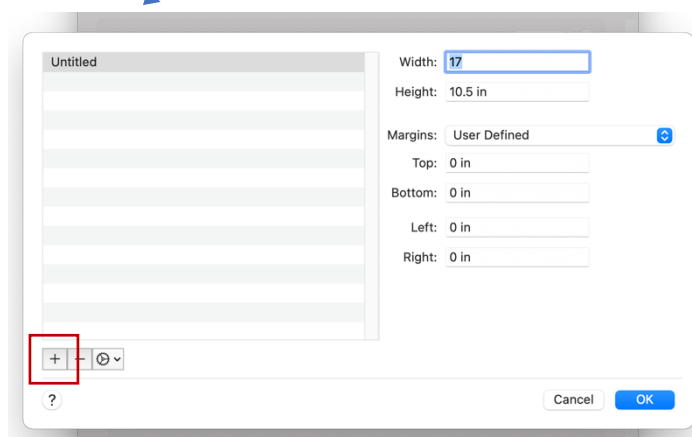
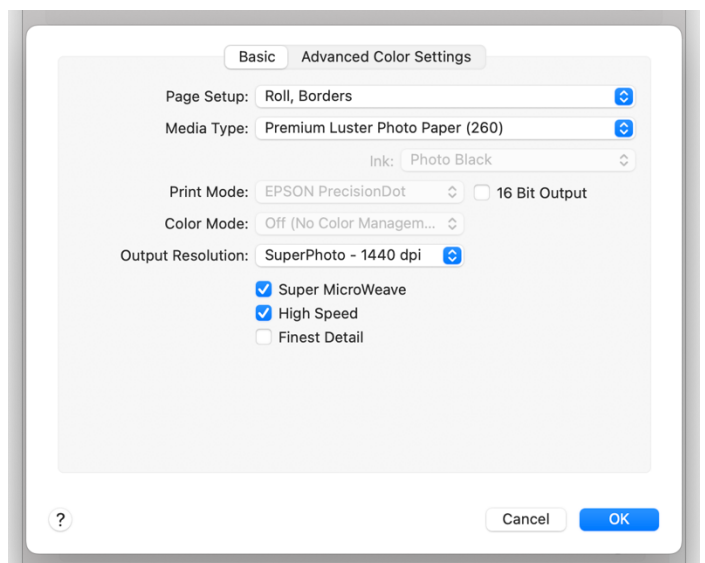
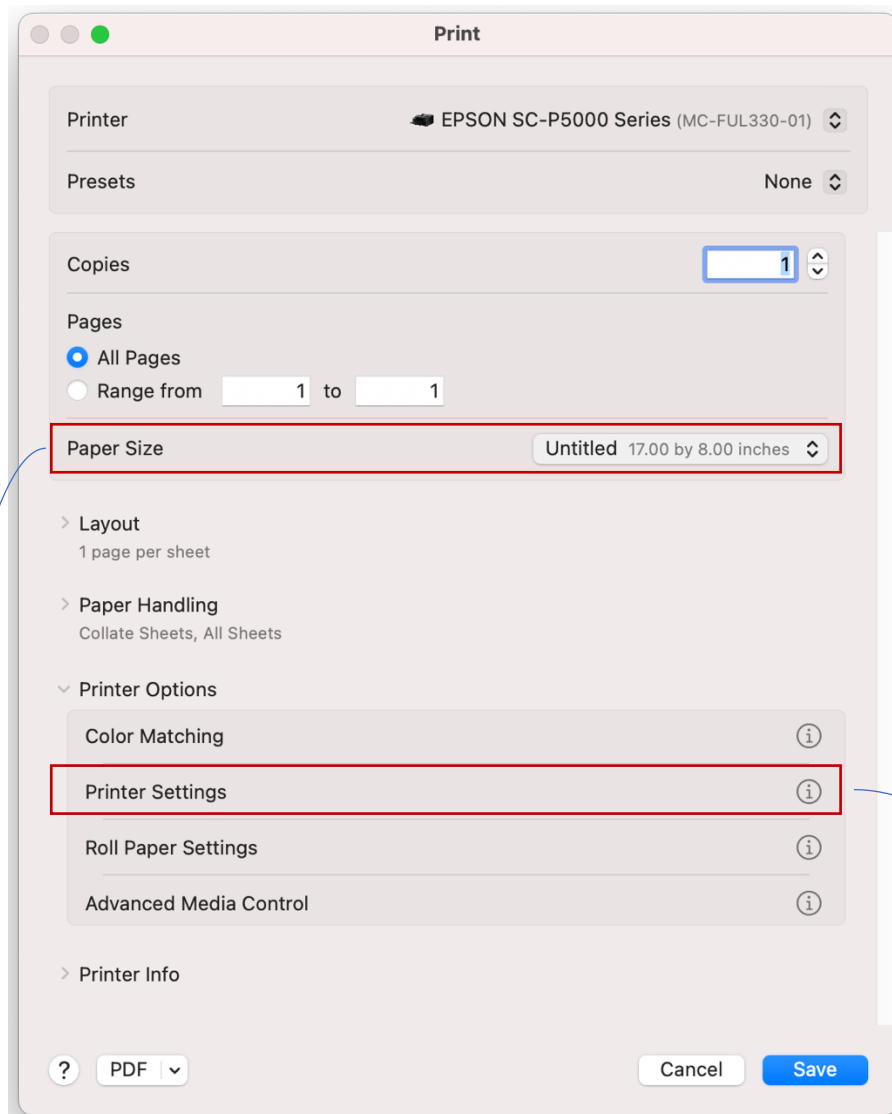
Printing Quick Guide

NOTE: This guide is a refresher for students who are already familiar with large-format printing. Please see the full guide for more information.



1. In Adobe Photoshop, go to the menu bar and scroll to: **Image > Image Size**
Take note of your image size (WxH) and resolution; resize if needed.
2. Scroll to: **File > Print**
This will open a new menu.
3. Select the printer:
Epson SC-P5000 series
4. Click on **Print Settings**
The “Print” dialog box will open automatically.
GO TO PAGE 2.
15. Layout: Rotate the orientation of the image as needed by clicking on the layout icons.
16. Color Handling:
Photoshop Manages Color
17. Printer Profile:
SC-P5000_Sries_LLK_PremiumLusterPhotoPaper260
(If using the general Art School roll paper)
18. Render Intent: **Perceptual**
(or a setting specific to your image)

Check **Black Point Compensation**
(or a setting specific to your image)
19. Print!



Paper Size > Manage Custom Sizes

Hit the + button to make a new size

17 in width (to match the roll paper size)

x in height (to match your other dimension)

0 in margin for Top/Bottom/Left/Right

Printer Options > Printer Settings

Choose: Roll, borders

Choose: Premium Luster Photo Paper (260)

Then **Save** and go back to page 1, step #15
