

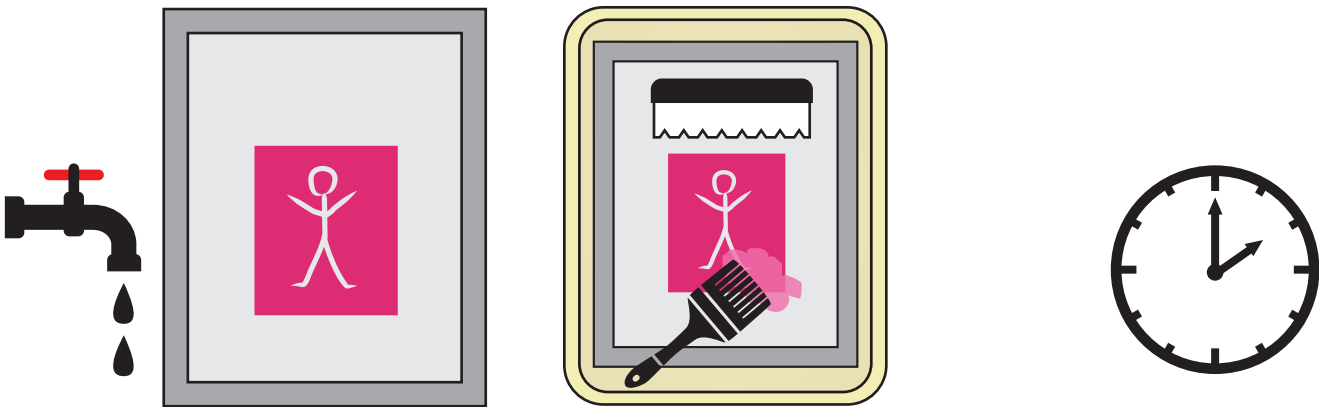
REMOVING DIAZO EMULSION



Remove the tape and ink from the screen.

Choose a tub large enough to soak the screen. Pour a layer of Diazo Emulsion Remover into the tub. Grab a scrub brush and brush (labeled for Emulsion remover).

Put on an apron and gloves.

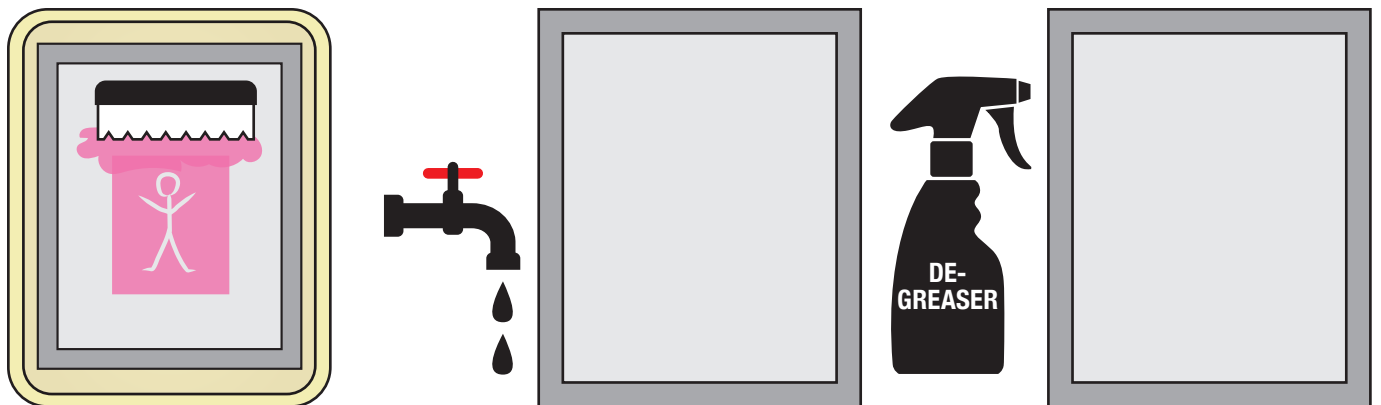


Wet the screen with water, preferably **HOT** water but any temperature is fine.

Place the screen in the Diazo Emulsion Remover, "paint" the solution onto both sides of the screen and scrub with the brush on each side.

Let the screen sit in the emulsion remover for 1-2 minutes while the emulsion breaks down.

DO NOT LET THE SCREEN DRY.



Place the print side down to support it on the bottom of the tub and scrub **HARD** with the brush. Flip and scrub slightly softer. **REPEAT.**

DO NOT LET THE SCREEN DRY.
KEEP SCRUBBING UNTIL CLEAR.

Spray out THOROUGHLY with a hard stream of HOT water (in spray booth) while scrubbing with a brush.

The emulsion should be completely out of the screen. Any residue will be a problem for the next person using the screen.

Spray degreaser (a specialized degreaser, vinegar, or dish soap) on both sides of the screen and scrub with a brush. Wash off thoroughly.
